Absolute Steel Air Tube Replacement

Tools Needed:

- 7/16" wrench or socket
- 3/4" wrench or socket
-1/2" wrench or socket
-screwdriver

1. Start by opening and removing the loading door. It is HEAVY so get a good grip on it. Push up the hinge pins from below and pull them out. Set aside.



2. Use a 1/2" wrench or socket to remove the nut from the end of the damper rod and remove rod. Set aside.



3. The rear panel of the stove is fastened in 7 places. Use a 7/16" wrench or socket to remove all the nuts, bolts, and washers.



4. Remove the back panel of the stove to expose the two air jets.



5. Use a 3/4" socket to remove the 2 air jet bolts. Set aside.

6. Open the ashpan door and remove ashpan, if present. Put your hand into the ashpan housing and push the ash grate up from below so you can pull it out through the loading door.



7. With the ash grate out, remove the 3 pieces of firebrick from the rear wall of the stove.



8. Insert a screwdriver through air jet hole on the back of the stove. Pull up, then push in so you can remove the air tube from inside the stove. Repeat for the second air tube on the other side of the stove.





9. To install new air tubes and air jets, follow all of the above procedures in reverse order.
